Submission guidelines:

- Refer the Urban Call for Proposal document and Submission templates prior filling out the details in the form.
- All information on the UIRP 1st Call for Proposals is available in three languages: English, French and Spanish. While UIRP strives to provide information in multiple languages, the applications will be limited to English.
- Please note: Applicants can create multiple proposals with same user id.
- All applicants are encouraged to complete the Initial Project Information submission as early as possible, allowing adequate time to receive intimation to proceed to next stage and submission of the Detailed Proposal.

Next steps:

 On submission of Initial Project Information applicants that meets the CfP eligibility criteria shall receive an invitation email from the CDRI team to proceed to the next stage.



Note: The Detailed Proposal Submission tab shall be automatically enabled for eligible applicants within Submission platform (on approval from CDRI team)

3. Step 2: Submit the Detailed Proposal Submission

Note: Refer the Detailed Proposal Submission template prior filling out the online form.

All applicants are encouraged to create offline workbooks with the templates provided in the CDRI Online Submission Platform.

Templates are provided for the following:

- Proposal Submission template
- **CV-key resources template** (to upload)
- Workplan-excel template (to upload)
- Budget-excel template (to upload)
- Letter of Support-template (to upload)

All submissions should adhere to the excel/document template provided by CDRI.

Under budget category it is mandatory to present as Results based budget (project outputs) and in UNSDG Budget categories. Submission shall be only allowed if both budget figures match.
